#### **Payment Policies**

The following fees are required at registration:

- 1. A \$50 non-refundable registration fee per camper (\$125 per family of 3 or more children). This fee is in addition to all other camp fees, and is not deductible from total amount due.
- 2. A one week deposit per camper. The deposit will be credited towards campers first week attending. In addition, a \$25 per week deposit for each week your child is registered to attend. The \$25 deposit will be credited to each week attended, and forfeited if your child has been signed up for said week but does not attend.
- 3. \*Returned Checks- In addition to any bank fees charged for returned checks, Camp Adventure will charge a \$25 service charge for any returned checks. Once a check has been returned by the bank, the customer must pay for camp fees with cash, a cashiers check, or money order. NO personal checks will be accepted after a returned check.
  - \*Weekly fees must be paid by the Friday prior to the session or week attending.

#### **Camp Policies**

- 1. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis. If for any reason the registration must be cancelled or changed, no refunds will be given.
- 2. No refunds or credit will be given for incomplete attendance.
- 3. In addition to a processing (registration) fee and deposit, all forms in our registration packet must be filled out completely. Please refer to the checklist provided with the application.
- 4. Campers with Special Needs Please let camp owners Scott and Fran know of any special needs your camper may have. Space is provided on application, but it's also good to share any concerns with Scott and Fran in person at registration.
- 5. Dismissal From Camp Camp Adventure's Owner/Directors reserve the right to terminate or suspend any camper, or deny his/her participation in any activity if his/her medical condition, conduct, influence, or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory and not in the best interest of Camp Adventure, Inc..
- 6. Stormy Weather Policy Don't forget, summer is hurricane season. If tropical storms or hurricane warnings threaten South Florida, Camp Adventure will be closed. Please call the camp ahead of time to get updates as needed. No refunds or credit will be given if camp has to be suspended during these times

Hello, and welcome to Camp Adventure for an exciting summer camp experience! In order for all campers to enjoy the benefits of a safe and exciting summer, we have adopted the following discipline policy into our program. It is understood that all campers attending camp this summer have reviewed the following rules with their parents prior to signing up, and that all rules will be followed while at Camp Adventure. After following the graduated discipline policy, if a camper continues to break camp rules and regulations, he/she will be dismissed from Camp Adventure, Inc., and no refund will be given.

#### **Camp Adventure Rules**

- 1. No camper will threaten another with violence. No hitting!
- 2. Campers will refrain from using profanity. No Cursing!
- 3. Campers will not take items from others. No Stealing

- 4. Campers will not destroy camp equipment and property.
- 5. NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONICS! Each Director will have a cell phone for emergency use. With the technology available today, it is impossible to monitor the use of cell phones and the appropriateness of what is being viewed. No Exceptions!

The following graduated discipline procedures are used by Camp Adventure, Inc.

- 1. <u>First Incident:</u> The child and counselor will sit and discuss the child's unacceptable behavior. The child may be given "time out" or asked to sit out during an activity.
- 2. <u>Second Incident:</u> The child, counselor, and director will meet to discuss the child's unacceptable behavior and decide cooperatively what can be done to improve the child's behavior. The child may be given "time out", or asked to sit out of an activity.
- 3. Third Incident: If the misbehavior continues, the camp director will call the camper's parents to discuss their child's behavior and what can be done to improve behavior.
- 4. <u>Fourth Incident:</u> If the misbehavior continues, the child will be suspended from Camp Adventure, Inc., for a time to be determined based on the severity of the misbehavior.
- 5. <u>Fifth Incident:</u> Upon return of the child from suspension, any further display of unacceptable behavior will result in the child being suspended from Camp Adventure, Inc., for the rest of the Summer. No refund will be given.
